Chinese Culture Studies Program for Global Young Scholar 2023 --- The international Sinology Youth Workshop

“Confucian Civilization and Chinese Path to Modernization”

- (1) How can human being and nature harmoniously co-exist?
- (2) How can we build a community with a shared future for mankind?
- (3) How can we strengthen the communication among different civilizations?

■ Time and Venue:

Time: Jul 10th-Jul 23rd, 2023

Venue: Beijing Normal University

Form: The program plans to be held both online and offline. Centering on the theme, we will organize a series of activities such as academic lectures, academic dialogues, cultural experiences, study tours, group discussions, creative activity and student presentations, so as to promote students' understanding toward the Chinese path to modernization in a combined pattern involving both theoretical exploration and actual experience.

■ Contents of Program:

1 Program background

The program will invite members of the International Confucian Association from Beijing Normal University as well as those other first-class universities at home and abroad, to become lecturers and tutors of our program. The School of Philosophy, BNU is one of the most important centers for philosophy and social science education, as well as for philosophical scientific research in China. In recent years, Philosophy at BNU as the “First-Class” discipline has been ranked 51-100 in QS steadily, and has been assessed as A in the fourth and fifth round of discipline evaluation of the China Ministry of Education. Each major in the School of Philosophy BNU has well-experienced faculty members and strong research capabilities. Our program has gained full support from the Center for Studies of Values and Culture at BNU which is a key research base of humanities and social sciences of the China Ministry of Education.

2 Program activities

Academic Lecture: All lectures, academic comments and Q&A sessions will be delivered by experts in the field of philosophy.

Tutorial Guide: Participants will be divided into tutorial groups according to topics, and academic tutors will provide specific guidance to the participants for preparing their presentations.

Academic Dialogue: “Thinking about China” Roundtable Forum - one scholar will be the host, and three experts will carry on a dialogue with a specific topic.

Cultural Experience: Specialized teaching fellows will demonstrate and lead the participants in hands on Chinese cultural activities, including Chinese calligraphy and Martial art.

Student Presentation: On the last day of the program, student representatives will share their learning harvest and make presentations.

Study Tours: Participants will pay a visit to the National Museum of China and the Guozijian (the Imperial Academy) in Beijing and go to Quzhou, the holy place of Southern Confucianism, for a 4-day trip.



3 Program Features

The program mainly targets at outstanding young overseas scholars engaged in philosophical and relevant research. The program has put the abundant academic resources of the International Confucian Association into full use, and will be conducted in the form of various activities such as academic lectures, discussions on specific topics, tutorial guides and student presentations. The program is characterized by diverse knowledge backgrounds, academic perspectives and teaching styles with the professional team involving a number of experts and scholars from the International Confucian Association. It is aimed to help participants to broaden their global horizons and improve their academic performances, thereby promoting international exchanges and cooperation, fostering new generation of academic scholars and developing their in-depth understandings of traditional Chinese thought and culture.

■ Admission Information:

1 Recruitment Target and Eligibility:

The main target group of this program are oversea young scholars are well engaged in philosophical and relevant research, along with young international students from universities in China.

- 1.Applicants must to be aged above 18, with a bachelor's degree or above, and have certain background or foundation of Chinese culture study,
- 2.We expect participants to have a strong academic interest in Chinese traditional culture and contemporary Confucianism, as well as a certain understanding and grasp of Chinese philosophy, history, literature, etc.
- 3.We also look forward to participants who show concern for public affairs and are willing to make positive contributions to Sino-foreign friendly communication and cooperation.

The Evaluation Committee will select 40 applicants to participate in the program, based on the overall quality of their submitted materials.

3 Scholarships

The International Confucian Association and Beijing Normal University will provide scholarships of different levels, covering the cost of round-trip international air tickets, lodging and sightseeing in China during the program.

To apply for the scholarship, please submit the following materials by sending an email to fuhualai@bnu.edu.cn before **15th April**:

(1) A short, separate letter outlining the applicant’s current funding status, financial needs and the estimated international travel expenses.

(2) An essay that discusses your interests in the topic “Chinese Thoughts and Modern Civilization”, and your relevant previous study experience in no less than 1000 words. Applicants do not necessarily require relevant study experience in the program’s topic.

***Notice:** This scholarship will be provided based on the assessment by the evaluation committee. Anyone offered the scholarship should meet the basic completion conditions.
